APPLICATION PROCESS

APPLY	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If you are interested, please complete and return the application form overleaf via email to: office@mrss.vic.edu.au • Stall sites will be approximately 3 x 3 metres. Some double sites may be available upon request at an extra cost.
ASSESS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Applications be will assessed based on the quality of the sale items, the alignment with the ethos/aesthetic of the school, and the overall variety of the market stalls as a whole. • All applicants will be advised of the outcome of their submission by Friday 30th August 2024.
FEES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Market fees are a fundraiser for MRSS. • Stallholders fees are \$80 (Makers) or \$110 (Mixed/Commercial reseller). • Double site cost: \$160 (Makers) or \$220 (Mixed/Commercial reseller) • Successful stallholders will be sent an invoice for stall fees which must be paid by Friday 18th October 2024.
FAIR DAY	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Successful stallholders will be emailed full details about Fair Day, including the set-up and pack-down procedure, in early November. • PLEASE BE AWARE – If your Fair Day stall items do not match our product categories, we reserve the right to require the removal of products, or refund stallholder fees and withdraw the site offered.
