FEES	<ul> <li>Market fees are a fundraiser for MRSS.</li> <li>Stallholders fees are \$80 (Makers) or \$110 (Mixed/Commercial reseller).</li> <li>Double site cost: \$160 (Makers) or \$220 (Mixed/Commercial reseller)</li> <li>Successful stallholders will be sent an invoice for stall fees which must be paid by Friday 18<sup>th</sup> October 2024.</li> </ul>
FAIR DAY	<ul> <li>Successful stallholders will be emailed full details about Fair Day, including the set-up and pack-down procedure, in early November.</li> <li>PLEASE BE AWARE – If your Fair Day stall items do not match our product categories, we reserve the right to require the removal of products, or refund stallholder fees and withdraw the site offered.</li> </ul>
